**From Primary 5 *upwards*, recorder is optional. School will provide necessary Tutor books for descant and/or treble Recorder, and parents will be charged accordingly.**

Girls already learning more than one instrument in school time will be able to go on doing so, but new pupils will only be able to take up one instrument or solo singing during class time; (lessons for any additional instrument(s) will take place outside school hours).

If a girl wishes to stop an **extra music** subject, her parents must notify the School **in writing one term in advance**. Other extra subjects require **half a term's notice**.
