Safe on-campus boarding accommodation in the heart of iconic Edinburgh

The <u>boarding house</u>, Houldsworth House, is adjacent to the school and on the main school campus. It is secure, small and friendly, and is home to around 50 girls.

The girls benefit from a family atmosphere, living in a close-knit environment structured in a similar way to siblings in a family, where older and younger housemates can learn from each other and offer support to one another.

Student Life

- Approximately 650 students, with 50 boarders from the UK and overseas.
- Boarding house has a friendly, family atmosphere.
- Half of boarders are from the UK and half international.
- Students take part in a wide variety of co-curricular as well as academic study: sports, arts, volunteering, international exchanges, residential camps, music, culture and much more.

By Air

Located on the west side of Edinburgh. Edinburgh Airport: 20 minutes (6 miles).

Glasgow Airport: 1 hour (52 miles). Edinburgh and Glasgow airports have direct flights from around 90 destinations worldwide.


One hour's transfers are also readily available from London's airports and Amsterdam's Schiphol airport.
