Adventure and wide-open spaces

Our Little Dragons nursery is part of our Junior School and enjoys superb indoor and outdoor facilities. Our bright, spacious playrooms and themed areas – from messy play to quiet corners – are perfect for both calm thinking and fiery ideas.

Outside, the adventure continues with landscaped gardens, the Fantastical Forest, the Secret Garden, our majestic fort, sandpit and wide-open space for imaginative quests and active play.

A seamless journey into school

We know every dragon family needs flexibility. Term-time sessions run from 8.30 am to 3.00 pm, with wraparound care from 7.45 am to 6.00 pm. Our Holiday Club runs throughout most of the year for children aged 3–8, offering consistency and comfort with familiar faces.
